The League of NH Craftsmen Hosts Exhibition: *Garden Imagery* February 6 – April 24, 2009 Gallery 205, Concord, NH

CONCORD, NH – The League of NH Craftsmen’s Gallery 205 is hosting an exhibition featuring the spirit and life of the garden through four seasons. Flowers, leaves, and plants are depicted in beautiful and creative ways through fine handcrafted pottery, jewelry, leather, fiber, wood, glass, prints, and photography. All of the pieces in this exhibition were made by juried members of the League (*a list of participants appears at the end of this release.*).

The exhibition will be in the League’s Gallery 205 in Concord from February 6 through April 24, 2009. An opening reception is scheduled for Friday, February 6 from 5:00 pm to 7:00 pm. The snow date for the opening reception is Friday, February 13. Gallery 205 is located in the League of NH Craftsmen’s headquarters at 205 North Main Street in Concord, NH and is open Monday through Friday, 8:30 am to 4:30 pm, and Saturdays, during the exhibition, 10:00 am to 4:00 pm.

“For many of us, the garden is our connection to nature – our way of interacting with the earth. Planting and growing flowers and vegetables is a fascinating, wondrous activity, and this exhibition celebrates it,” said League Executive Director Susie Lowe-Stockwell. “It also offers a welcome respite from the winter weather.”
