The exhibition features a wide array of distinctive fine craft, including jewelry, fiber, clay, metal sculpture, wood, baskets, photography, leather, and mixed media pieces.

The exhibition will be in the League’s Gallery 205 in Concord from January 29 through March 26, 2010. An opening reception is scheduled for Friday, January 29 from 5:00 pm to 7:00 pm. Gallery 205 is located in the League of NH Craftsmen’s headquarters at 205 North Main Street in Concord, NH and is open Monday through Friday, 8:30 am to 4:30 pm, and Saturdays, during the exhibition, 10:00 am to 4:00 pm.

The exhibition is being sponsored by E. Leslie Stone, a weaver, member of the League’s Gallery 205 Committee since 2003, and a League volunteer for about 40 years.

“This is an exhibition that we feel people will easily relate to and enjoy,” said League Executive Director Susie Lowe-Stockwell. “The functional and fanciful fine craft in this exhibition represent many different interpretations and stories about love and romance.”
