

NH High School Senior Craft Education Scholarship Application Information

Purpose

The NH High School Senior Craft Education Scholarship Program of the League of NH Craftsmen, Inc. is administered by the League Education Committee and is designed to provide supplementary financial assistance to students pursuing an education in the field of craft related studies.

Eligibility

Anyone living in New Hampshire or within ten miles of its border is eligible to receive a High School Senior Craft Education Scholarship. The application process is competitive. The Education Committee is interested in supporting intensive educational activities that present creative approaches to learning and are designed to:

- Meet the challenges of a career as a professional craftsman
- Develop a personal interest in a craft discipline
- Improve personal understanding of a craft-related topic such as design or aesthetics
- Advance a skill or learn a new technique in a craft medium
- Enhance individual creativity

Application Deadlines

Applications for the High School Senior Craft Education Scholarships must be submitted by **April 1**. The Scholarship Panel will review all applications and make recommendations to the Education Committee. Payment of scholarships will be made in June.
